Allan Rubenstein Camp Director

Allan Rubenstein, Director for Inland Volleyball Club, has been the Head Volleyball Coach for Timber Creek High School for 7 years. Allan led Timber Creek to win the 2008 Girls' 6A State Championship. The girls' team was also the State Runner-up two seasons ago, and the boys' program has reached the state finals twice. He was named Coach of the Year five different times. Coach Rubenstein has 17 years experience coaching club volleyball and has also coached at the collegiate level when he served as Assistant Coach for the Rollins College Tars and the University of Tulsa. His playing experience includes a collegiate men's club team, many USAV adult teams, and numerous beach tournaments. Coach Rubenstein coached the 16-Elite team during the 2010 club season, oversees club operations, and also serves as the College Recruiting Coordinator for IVC.



Stephanie Feulner Camp Coach

Stephanie Feulner graduated from Bishop Moore High School where she played volleyball and soccer. Stephanie led the Hornets to 2 State Soccer Championships. She went to the University of North Florida on a volleyball scholarship where she earned several accolades. Stephanie transferred to Saint Louis University to play Division I volleyball. While at SLU she helped to lead the Billikens to the NCAA National Invitational while earning All-Conference First Team honors and AVCA National Athlete of the Week. Stephanie was selected SLU Outstanding Female Athlete of the Year. She served as Assistant Volleyball Coach for Georgia State University in 1997, and served as Assistant Coach for Timber Creek High School for three seasons. Stephanie is an inductee of both the Bishop Moore Hall of Fame and the Saint Louis University Hall of Fame.



Natalie Bookal Camp Coach

Natalie Bookal graduated from Boynton Beach High School where she was a starter on the varsity volleyball team for four years, and led her team to two district championships, a regional championship, and a third place finish at the state championship.
